SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Student and College Ministries CCO Jubilee Scholarship Criteria

EPC Student and College Ministries is committed to extending scholarship awards to college students and young adults (age 17-29), based on financial need, who are attending Jubilee in Pittsburg, Pa. Eligibility is based on financial need and aims to help college students and young adults for whom financial assistance can mean the difference between participation in Jubilee and staying home.

The number of scholarships awarded is limited by the donations raised for the EPC College Conference Scholarship Fund. The EPC Student and College Ministries Committee determines scholarship amounts, reviews applications and awards the scholarships.

Q. What are the criteria to qualify for a scholarship?

A. Criteria:

1. Applicants are college students or young adults (age 17-29).
2. Applicants are members, attend, or recommended by leaders of an Evangelical Presbyterian Church.
3. Applicants are registered to attend Jubilee or are able to show proof of registration, upon notification of receipt of scholarship funds.
4. Applicants have church or ministry leadership references.
5. Applicants demonstrate some mission experience, call or church/ministry involvement.
6. Applicants demonstrate financial need in order to attend Jubilee.

Q. What is the amount of the scholarship per applicant?

A. Up to \$50.00, based upon need.

Q. How many scholarships are awarded?

A. The number of scholarships awarded is limited by the donations raised for the "College Conference Scholarships Fund" and by the number of qualified applicants, as determined by EPC Student and College Ministries Committee members.

Q. What is the deadline for applying?

A. Applicants are considered upon receipt until February 1, 2016, or until all scholarship funds have been distributed (whichever comes first). Late applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Q. Who decides if I receive a scholarship?

A. Applications are reviewed and decisions made by the EPC Student and College Ministries Committee.

Q. How will I know if I received a scholarship?

A. If approved for a scholarship, you will receive e-mail correspondence or a telephone call from a committee or staff member of the EPC Student and College Ministries.
